Education foundations nationwide were created in the late 1970's as public school budgets across the country were significantly reduced. To offset the serious financial crisis in our schools, and to bridge the financial gap between what was needed for our students and state and federal funding, the Holdrege Public Schools Foundation was formed in 1988 with a \$30,000 grant from the Phelps County Community Foundation for the purpose of establishing an endowment. For the past twenty years our community has responded to the district's needs with tremendous support, recognizing that in today's world, private funding is crucial for public education. Our HPS Foundation Committee is comprised of three school board members, two staff members, and five community members who meet monthly and work on various projects throughout the vear.

Swedish Days ~ HHS All-Class Reunion



The annual Swedish Days celebration, held the weekend of June 16-17, will also feature the new Central Plains RibFest. The nationally sanctioned BBQ contest will bring teams from across the Midwest.

Ribfest activities begin on Friday, June 16, at 5:30^{pm} with an event similar to past Swedish Days RibFest events. Families and the public are invited to purchase and taste ribs and pork loin prepared by local cooks and some of the professional BBQ

contestants. The public will vote for their favorite ribs and pork loin along with "celebrity" judges. Local cooks are also invited to participate in the Holdrege Market Place Steak Fry to vie for top honors in cooking steaks.

Friday night's event also includes a beer garden and a street dance featuring The James Lee Band, a country western group from Greeley, Neb. The *Holdrege High School All-Class Reunion* will also be part of Friday night's RibFest activities.

Tickets for the event are \$5 in advance/\$10 at the gate for the family-friendly tasting event from 5:30-8^{pm} or \$10 in advance/\$15 at the gate for the tasting event, beer garden, and street dance from 5:30^{pm}-midnight.

RibFest will take place in downtown Holdrege near the city auditorium with the main gate at 5^{th} and West avenues and additional gates at 6^{th} and Grant streets and 5^{th} and Tilden streets.
