Instruction

Scope of Instructional Program

- A. The District shall provide instruction suitable to the needs of all who are legally eligible to attend school in the District.
- B. Except for special types of instruction, the instructional program may be arranged in units commonly designated as grades, each grade approximately the work of one year. Such a program of instruction shall be organized into schools or other administrative units as follows:
 - 1. The elementary school(s) shall provide for the instruction of children Kindergarten through fourth grade.
 - 2. The middle school shall provide for the instruction of children in grades five through eight.
 - 3. The secondary school shall provide for the instruction of children in grades nine through twelve.
 - 4. Instruction appropriate to the needs of the community and individuals may be provided for adults and others beyond the age required to attend school.
 - 5. Departures from the above noted organizational plan for instruction may be made by the Superintendent of Schools upon approval of the Board of Education.
