Education foundations nationwide were created in the late 1970's as public school budgets across the country were significantly reduced. To offset the serious financial crisis in our schools, and to bridge the financial gap between what was needed for our students and state and federal funding, the Holdrege Public Schools Foundation was formed in 1988 with a \$30,000 grant from the Phelps County Community Foundation for the purpose of establishing an endowment. For the past twenty years our community has responded to the district's needs with tremendous support, recognizing that in today's world, private funding is crucial for public education. Our HPS Foundation Committee is comprised of three school board members, two staff members, and five community members who meet monthly and work on various projects throughout the vear.

2016 Teacher Grants Awarded

Teacher grant requests totaling more than \$11,600 were submitted for the 2016 teacher grant cycle. Due to the unfavorable economic climate, there were no earnings available, therefore, the Board accessed the expendable balance to award two grants totaling \$2,013.44. Thanks to the HPS Foundation Committee for all their work to evaluate the grant applications, and to all those who support the HPS Foundation to make these funds available for our teachers and classroom projects.
