

Business and Non-Instructional OperationsPublic Gifts to School

The Board may accept, on behalf of and for the school district, any bequest or gift of money or property for a purpose deemed by the Board to be suitable, and to utilize such money or property so designated.

Along with gifts of money, the Board welcomes and encourages suggestions regarding its use. However, the final decision as to exactly how the money is to be expended must lie solely in the hands of the Board of Education of the Holdrege Public School.

Any gift presented to the school district must be given without placing restriction on the school program. All gifts, grants, and bequests shall become school district property.

The Board of Education may deny any gifts and grants, etc. which it deems to be inappropriate, a conflict of interest, or harmful to the best interest of the educational process at Holdrege Public Schools.
