#### **Treats at School**

If you send treats to school with your child for a birthday or a class party, please be sure that they are store-purchased, individually wrapped treats. #### Free Breakfasts and Lunches for All HPS Students

Holdrege Public Schools has received a waiver from the USDA to provide FREE breakfast and lunch to ALL students, beginning August 13th through December 18th, or until funds run out. Students will be charged for additional items outside of the standard meal, such as second entrees, additional milk, or other ala carte items. Snack milk for Kindergarten students is **not** covered by the waiver and will be charged. This waiver does NOT apply to adult meals. Any money currently in a student's meal account will remain in the account. We will begin the process of crediting back charges to the student's account for meals previously purchased. Menus are subject to change due to product availability.

#### **Colder Weather**

With fall just arriving, the weather can be quite deceiving. Although the forecast may call for afternoons in the 70s and 80s, the mornings are still quite cold. Please make sure your children come to school with coats and socks, and if necessary, hats, mittens, and boots. Please do not send your child to school with open-toed shoes or flip-flops. We will be going outside at recess whenever possible. Children should not be at school before 7:30 AM.

#### **Go Dusters!**

We encourage our students and staff to wear purple and gold on Fridays to show our school spirit and support our school.

#### **Activities and Behavior**

We would appreciate it if you would talk to your children about their behavior at games and other activities. We would like students to come to the games to support the teams playing. We do not, however, want them to come to the games and run around all of the time. For the safety of your child, we will not allow this type of behavior or the playing of street-yard football games on the side of the stadium. Students will be expected to sit with their parents. Students who do not follow the guidelines of the school will be asked to leave the premises. A los estudiantes se les cobrará por artículos adicionales fuera de la comida estándar, como segundos platos, leche adicional u otros artículos a la carta. La merienda para los estudiantes de kinder no está cubierta por la exención y se le cobrará. Esta exención NO se aplica a las comidas para adultos. Cualquier dinero que esté actualmente en la cuenta de comidas de un estudiante permanecerá en la cuenta. Comenzaremos el proceso de acreditar los cargos atrasados a la cuenta del estudiante por las comidas compradas previamente. Los menús están sujetos a cambios debido a la disponibilidad del producto.

#### Tiempo Más Frío

#### **School Closing Information**

When weather is a concern, parents ultimately have the final decision on whether or not to send children to school or to pick them up early. An attempt will be made to have school every scheduled day. If, however, due to inclement weather or if unforeseen circumstances arise, Radio Station KUVR Holdrege and Television Station KHGI Channel 13 Kearney will carry information in relation to the school closing. Information will also be posted at www.holdregedusters.org and automated phone calls will be made.

School may be delayed to allow for additional assessment of weather conditions and/or for snow removal. Announcements will be made if food service (breakfast/lunch) schedules are disrupted.

If weather conditions develop during the day that warrants dismissal, the same procedure will be followed. Conditions may exist that children on bus routes will be dismissed and taken home, but school will remain in session.

Please make a plan with your children as to what to do or where to go if school has to be closed early with little warning. It is a concern that students do not know what to do in such a situation. Phone calls and messages are difficult to dispatch at this time. It helps if your child has an idea of what he/she is to do in these situations ahead of time.

#### **PTO Reminder**

The Elementary PTO reminds all families to save Box Tops and SunMart receipts. The money raised from collecting these help with purchasing school supplies not covered by the regular budget, activities such as the annual elementary field day snacks, and to purchase a book for each elementary child twice a year.
