### **School Closing Information**

School may be delayed to allow for additional assessment of weather conditions and/or for snow removal. Announcements will be made if food service (breakfast/lunch) schedules are disrupted. If weather conditions develop during the day that warrants dismissal, the same procedure will be followed. Conditions may exist that children on bus routes will be dismissed and taken home, but school will remain in session.

### **Colder Weather**

The cold weather has arrived and it is here to stay. Please make sure that your children come to school prepared for the cold weather. This means a heavy coat, and if necessary, a hat, mittens/gloves, and boots. If there is snow, students will not be allowed to play off the cleared, hard cement surfaces unless they are wearing snow boots and possibly snow pants depending on how deep the snow is. We will be going outside whenever possible as it is important for the children to get some fresh air and exercise during the day.



Staying indoors for recess will be decided by the building principal. As outlined in the Student-Parent Handbook, if the weather is not severe, children will be outside for recess if the temperature is above 20° and the wind chill is above 10°. Be sure to dress your child properly for the elements.

Students will be charged for additional items outside of the standard meal, such as second entrees, additional milk, or other ala carte items. Snack milk for Kindergarten students is **not** covered by the waiver and will be charged. This waiver does NOT apply to adult meals. Any money currently in a student's meal account will remain in the account. We will begin the process of crediting back charges to the student's account for meals previously purchased.
