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NSCAS and MAP Testing

All Holdrege students in grades 3 through 8 will be taking the NSCAS (Nebraska Student-Centered Assessment System) reading and math tests this year as part of the state requirements mandated by the Nebraska Unicameral. These are very important tests that will measure student performance across the state of Nebraska in reading, vocabulary and comprehension, and math skills. NSCAS Reading tests will be the week of March 29-April 2. The NSCAS Math tests will be the week of April 13-16. All kindergarten through 4th grade students will take MAP and DIBELS tests this spring as well. These tests will be administered from April 19-30. Teachers have been working with students all year to learn the skills that will be assessed. Please encourage your child to do their best on these tests. It is very important the students get their rest and attend school on these dates.

School Closing Information

When weather is a concern, parents ultimately have the final decision on whether or not to send children to school or to pick them up early. An attempt will be made to have school every scheduled day. If, however, due to inclement weather or if unforeseen circumstances arise, Radio Station KUVR Holdrege and Television Station KHGI Channel 13 Kearney will carry information in relation to the school closing. Information will also be posted at www.dusters.org and automated phone calls will be made.



School may be delayed to allow for additional assessment of weather conditions and/or for snow removal. Announcements will be made if food service (breakfast/lunch) schedules are disrupted. If weather conditions develop during the day that warrants dismissal, the same procedure will be followed. Conditions may exist that children on bus routes will be dismissed and taken home, but school will remain in session.

PTO Reminder

If you would like to help the Elementary PTO all year, you can save your Sunmart receipts and send them with your student to school. You can also download the Box Tops app for your phone, select Holdrege Elementary School as your recipient, and scan your receipts with Box Tops eligible items. Please encourage your family and friends to help us out too. The money raised from collecting these helps the PTO purchase school supplies not covered by the regular budget and to purchase a book for each elementary child twice a year.



Last Day of School

The last day of school for all Holdrege Public School students is Wednesday, May 19. Students will be dismissed at 12:00 PM and there will be no lunch served that day. Final report cards will be distributed that day.

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Exámenes NSCAS and MAP

Todos los estudiantes de Holdrege entre los grados de 3-8 tomarán la examinación de lectura NSCAS (Nebraska Student-Centered Assessment System) este año como parte de los requisitos del estado ordenados por la Unicameral de Nebraska. Este es un examen muy importante el cual medirá el rendimiento de estudiantes a través del estado de Nebraska en las áreas de vocabulario de lectura y comprensión, y destrezas matemáticas. Exámenes en Lectura de NSCAS serán dados en la semana 29 de marzo -2 de abril. Exámenes de Matemáticas en NSCAS serán dados en la semana de abril 13-16. Todos los niños del kínder a cuarto grado tomaran el examen de MAP y DIBELS esta primavera también. Estas pruebas se administrará 19-30 de abril. Los maestros han estado trabajando con los estudiantes el año entero para aprender las destrezas que serán examinadas. Favor de alentar a su niño a hacer lo mejor posible en estos exámenes. **Es muy importante que los estudiantes descansen y asistan a la escuela durante estas fechas.**

Información de Cierre de Escuelas

Cuando el tiempo es de preocupación, los padres ultimadamente toman la decisión final de mandar o no a sus niños a la escuela o de recogerlos temprano. Se hará un atento para tener clases planificadas todos los días. Sin embargo, debido al mal tiempo o si hay circunstancias no previstas que surjan, la Estación de Radio KUVR de Holdrege y la Estación de Televisión KHGI Canal 13 de Kearney tendrán información en relación al cierre de escuelas. La información también estará puesta en www.dusters.org y se harán llamadas de teléfono automáticas. La escuela podría ser retrasada para permitir el asesoramiento adicional de las condiciones del tiempo y/o para la removida de nieve. Habrán anuncios hechos si el horario del servicio de comidas (desayuno/almuerzo) es cambiado. Si hay condiciones del tiempo que se desarrollan durante el día las cuales requieren la salida de la escuela, se seguirá el mismo procedimiento. Podrían existir condiciones en las cuales lo niños en rutas de autobús serán mandados a la casa, pero la escuela seguirá en sesión.



El Recordatorio PTO



2020-21 Return to School Plan

Holdrege Public Schools will utilize information from health care professionals at Phelps Memorial Health Center (PMHC) and Family Medical Specialties (FMS) to assess COVID-19 spread risk levels on a continual basis and communicate operational impacts on curricular and extracurricular programs and district operations via the district website, notification system, and social media pages. This information is being provided to HPS families so that they can help their students prepare for a successful transition to the 2020-21 school year. It is imperative that staff, students, and parents communicate and support the educational process to help students succeed.

Temperature Checks & Screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Families should practice at-home screening for temperature, cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, and other symptoms. Students should not report to school if symptomatic.  Temperature checks will be conducted upon arrival at school. Students with a temperature of 100 degrees or more will be provided a mask if needed, isolated, and sent home. 			
Return to School After Illness	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  Students returning to school after illness must be fever and symptom free without medication for a full day (24 hours) to return to school and will be required to wear a mask while in attendance for 7 days.  Students returning to school after illness must be fever and symptom free without medication for three days (72 hours) to return to school and will be required to wear a mask while in attendance for 7 days. 			
Student Drop Off & Pick Up	<p>Parents are asked to stay in or by their vehicle when dropping off or picking up students. Students may not congregate at entrances.</p> <p>Social distancing practices should be followed. PK-4 students will be seated by class in the gym.</p> <p>Students arriving after the school day begins must report to office.</p> <p>Students will be dismissed as usual.</p>			
Masks, Social Distancing & Safe Hygiene Practices	<p>IMPORTANT NOTE: Masks are encouraged – students and staff are much more likely to be able to remain in school and active in extracurricular activities if they have been wearing a mask during the time they may have been exposed to another individual who tested positive for COVID-19.</p> <p>HPS may provide a limited number of cloth face masks per student and staff member throughout the year. The family is responsible for cleaning and sanitizing cloth face masks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  Masks are encouraged, but not required with attention to social distancing and safe hygiene practices.  Masks are encouraged, but not required with attention to social distancing, safe hygiene practices, and implementation of frequent disinfecting of high traffic areas.  Masks will be worn throughout the day with increased attention to social distancing, safe hygiene practices, and implementation of frequent disinfecting of high traffic areas. Masks will be optional when outside or in situations where wearing masks may not be feasible. <p>If there are circumstances related to qualifying disabilities such that a student or staff member cannot wear a face mask, then a face shield or other accommodation may be utilized.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  Students and staff will sanitize their hands upon entering the building, each classroom, and cafeteria. PK-4 students will have scheduled hand washing and hand sanitizing throughout the day. Grades 5-12 students will be reminded of safe hygiene practices. Drinking fountains will be shut off and students will use their water bottles and refill at the filler stations. Students will maintain hygiene of laptops or other technology devices. 			

Transportation	<p>Masks: ■ Optional; ■ Required</p> <p>■ Normal rural and in-town shuttle routes. Parents are encouraged to bring their child to school if they can to assist with social distancing on buses. Students will load back to front and unload front to back.</p> <p>■ In the morning, students will have their temperature checked prior to boarding the bus. A parent, or other responsible adult, is expected to wait at the bus stop until the student boards the bus. Any student that fails to pass the temperature screening will not be permitted to board the bus and will be sent home with the parent or responsible adult. Students will load back to front and unload front to back.</p> <p>■ In-town courtesy shuttle service will be suspended. UPDATED: Effective January 11, 2021 courtesy shuttle service will be provided in the orange risk level.</p> <p>■ No transportation due to remote learning.</p>
Food Service	<p>Food service staff will follow safety protocols and wear PPE.</p> <p>No salad bar.</p> <p>■ ■ PK-4 students eat breakfast/lunch in cafeteria with social distancing.</p> <p>■ ■ 5-12 students grab and go breakfast and eat lunch in cafeteria with social distancing.</p> <p>■ District may provide a pick-up only breakfast and lunch program.</p>
Facilities Cleaning	<p>Additional safety protocols will be utilized at increased risk levels.</p> <p>Normal cleaning procedures, including using disinfect wipes, disinfectant fogger and sprayer, and other cleaning products as needed.</p> <p>Classrooms will be cleaned during the teacher’s planning period or each night including wiping down of door knobs, desks, chairs, and common equipment.</p> <p>Lunchroom will be cleaned after breakfast and lunch each day.</p> <p>Cleaning procedures include light switches, doors knobs, hallways, and restrooms,</p> <p>Gloves and PPE equipment may be used by custodial staff.</p> <p>Students will wipe down their own laptops, desk, chair, and lockers.</p>
Extracurricular Programs & Field Trips	<p>NSAA guidelines will be followed.</p> <p>■ Sports, activities, and field trips will proceed with social distancing when possible.</p> <p>■ Temperature screening will be conducted daily for participants and staff, as well as prior to boarding any activities bus or van. Student sports participants will be issued a water bottle. Safe hygiene practices and cleaning protocols will be followed. At increased risk levels, small group and individual drills will be emphasized rather than full team contact. Field trips may be suspended.</p> <p>■ Extracurricular activities and field trips will be suspended.</p>
Visitors & Volunteers	<p>Visitors will be allowed to enter the building during school hours at COVID-19 risk levels of green, yellow, and orange with prior approval only. Visitors will be required to follow all rules associated with the current risk level. No visitors will be allowed to enter the building during school hours when the COVID-19 risk level is red.</p> <p>Lunch guests, classroom volunteers, mentors, and other special drop-in guests will not be allowed until further notice.</p> <p>Family members will be allowed for special meetings such as IEP and health-related meetings.</p>
Response to Positive COVID-19 Cases	<p>When a positive HPS student or staff COVID-19 case is confirmed, the individual will not be in attendance until medical clearance is obtained. HPS administration and staff will consult with local medical professionals from PMHC and/or FMS to consider the following questions when determining how that case will impact others on campus.</p> <p>... <i>What is the level of community spread outside the school building?</i></p> <p>... <i>Was the individual with COVID-19 wearing a mask most of the time?</i></p> <p>... <i>Were other students and staff who were within 6 feet of the individual with COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes masked?</i></p> <p>... <i>Was the individual with COVID-19 part of a cohort within the building or did they interact with a large number of students and staff throughout their day?</i></p> <p>... <i>To what extent is the school community implementing other non-pharmaceutical interventions (hand washing, hand sanitizers, etc.)?</i></p> <p>The answers to these questions will determine the following: 1) the number of close contacts; 2) if the close contacts who are not symptomatic may stay in school; and 3) the number of other students and staff who will need to be quarantined.</p>
