Career Pathways and general education courses allow juniors and seniors to take college courses while in high school. Students may earn high school and college credit at the same time. These courses are known as dual credit or concurrent enrollment. Tuition assistance may also be available. For more information, check with your school counselor.

Students have the opportunity to take a sequence of courses leading to a college certificate, diploma, and degree. High school students commonly select from the course listing and available online.
